Hymn:

all numbered. Fear not, therefore; you are of more value than many sparrows. So every one who acknowledges me before men, I also will acknowledge before my Father who is in heaven.

Priest:

Lord God of our salvation, we pray to you. As you blessed David through the hand of the prophet Samuel, likewise now bless this child through my unworthy hand, and fill him with your Holy Spirit, so that as s/he grows up and grows older he may enjoy your goodness. In all things glory and dominion to you, now and always and unto the ages of ages. Amen.
